2010 Budget Includes Bloomfield Stairs, Basics

The 2010 budget for your neighborhood association includes up to \$3,500 for construction of stairs at the east end of Bloomfield and otherwise covers the basics.

We expect \$9,870 of income from annual dues, which are \$70 per household this year, plus \$240 in interest income and \$125 from directory advertising sales. If you'd like to advertise in the directory, please check the checkbox on the directory information form accompanying your dues statement.

Expenses for the year will include up to \$1,000 for the annual dinner, up to \$1,000 for a block party, \$1,400 for insurance, \$1,090 for park and pathway maintenance, \$800 for property taxes, and up to \$600 for printing and photocopying. We will reduce that last

expense somewhat by switching our photocopying business from Staples to the locally owned Design 2 Print on Henry Street.

We also expect to spend about \$100 on additional garage sale signs, up to \$126 on postage, about \$125 on our Web site, and \$25 to file a required form with the State of Michigan.

With depreciation of \$1,140, the budget shows an operating loss of \$671 for the year. We hope to spend less than we've budgeted on a few of the major items, particularly the Bloomfield stairs, to finish in the black.

Thanks to Treasurer Tom Sanocki for preparing a solid and responsible budget, which the Board of Directors approved at a quarterly meeting in November.
